The fearsome dragon with long winding body and eyes like fire strikes at sirgurds tall sheild with its three pronged tongue.

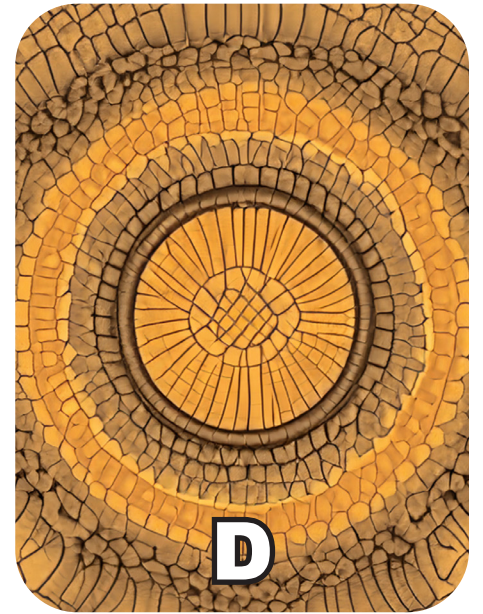
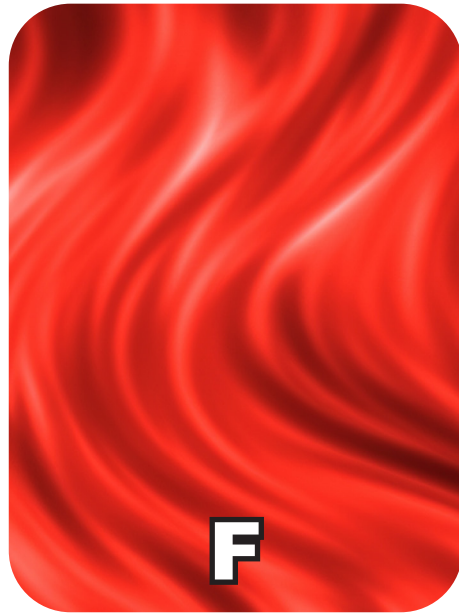
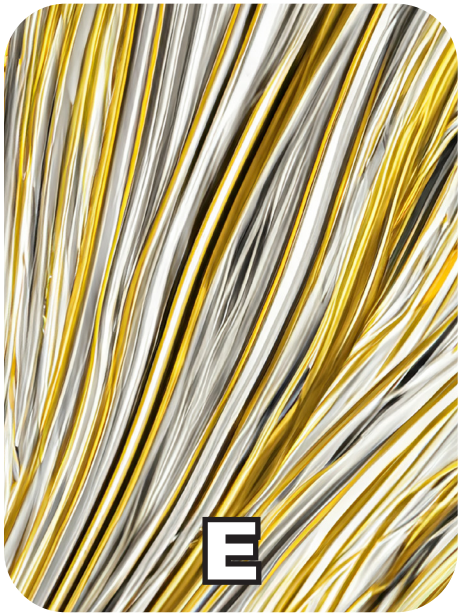


Instructions

These story cards relate to one part of tthe Hylestad portal. The picture cards relate to things within these stories.

Read the text and try to find the matching card.

Study the portal and see if you can find the correct order to tell the story.



A peice of bubble wrap

This bumpy texture of the wrap good symbolise the skin of the dragon, or slithery smooth bodies of the snakes.

Pair with iii or vii

The middle of some cardboard

Find some normal cardboard, peel off one sideso you can see the ridges in the middle. These ridges might feel like the strings of a harp.

Pair with iii

Wool or shaggy cloth

Something soft and fluffy could represent the shaggy mane of Grane the strong horse.

Pair with iv.

Card wrapped in foil

A long narrow piece of card wrapped in metal foil could be the sword with its hard smooth surface. Or could it be the treasure in iv if you ad a little more weight to it?

Pair with i or iv

Tissue paper

Don't let your fingers do all the thinking, use your ears.

A scrunching a peice of tissue paper can be the sound of a crackling fire while the the dragons heart barbe-cues.

pair with ii.

Peices of biscuit

Break a biscuit or crispbread to resemble the shattered peices that make up the magical sword Gram.

When you finish the game you can eat them and maybe get some of Grams magic as well!

pair with v

and so on...
